SIAST TO RECEIVE CHIEF JUSTICE E.M. CULLITON 'RIGHT TO KNOW' AWARD

The Saskatchewan Right to Know Committee (RTK Committee) has announced that the **Saskatchewan Institute of Applied Science and Technology (SIAST)** will receive the 2009 *Chief Justice E.M. Culliton 'Right to Know' Award*.

RTK Committee spokesman, Gary Dickson, stated that “SIAST has demonstrated impressive leadership in the commitment it has made to be transparent to its 13,000 students, 2,360 employees and the public. This includes new tools, guides, Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs), revised forms and an ambitious training program.”

The Culliton Award will be presented at the major event in Regina, September 30, 2009 to which the public is invited. This will include the keynote presentation by **Janet Keeping – *The Struggle Against Corruption; The Rule of Law and “Right to Know” – an international perspective.*** Janet Keeping is the President of the Sheldon Chumir Foundation for Ethics in Leadership. She has extensive experience working internationally, particularly in Russia.
